<u>Special Event Permit Application- Streamin the Gap Airstream Rally</u> The special event application, was submitted by Mary Mars/Guardians of the Gap and is scheduled for October 19- 22, 2023.

Other items: Road on Ashton Street- After the rain last week the hillside behind the First Baptist Church began separating from the road. According to the city attorney the town is responsible for repairing the street, while the church would be responsible for any repairs on their property. Engineers have looked at the site and have determined the need for a Geotech to test to the soil. In the meantime, the town will research liability issues if the town were to cause the hillside to further slide and damage the church or their property.
