Refunding Proposal for Outstanding Rural Development Bond Issue

The town recorder contacted Tennessee Municipal Bond Fund about the possibility of refunding the outstanding Rural Development Sewer Revenue Tax Bond. The current remaining term is 32 years, interest rate of 4.25%, and annual debt service payments of \$18,756. The Tennessee Municipal Bond Fund proposal includes a 20 year term, interest rate of 3.21%, and annual debt service payments of \$22,600. With the new proposal, the fixed rate can be locked in for 5 years, and at the end of the 5 year period the rate could raise, lower, or stay the same.

The board was concerned about the possibility of the rate increasing every 5 years considering the current rate of 4.25% is locked in for the remaining terms. The issue will be looked into further and will be discussed again next month. In the meantime, Rural Development will be contacted to see if the monthly payments can be increased to shorten the life of the loan.
