New Business:

Approve The Pineapple Tea Room to sell beer to go

The Governor's Executive Order No. 17 allows the establishments that hold an Alcoholic Beverage Commission (ABC) liquor license to temporarily make carryout and delivery sales of alcoholic beverages and beer with food sales. This order does not apply to those who does not have an ABC liquor license. It is at the discretion of each local beer boards to permit or prohibit the temporary sale of beer for carryout and delivery food sales.

John Douglas made motion to permit The Pineapple Tea Room (the only establishment this order will effect) to temporarily make carryout and delivery sales of beer with food sales. John Ravnum seconded the motion. On voice call vote all voted "aye."
