Off Premise Consumption Beer Permit Application Form-Kevin Larew/Angelo's in the Gap

At the last weeks planning meeting, Keven Larew explained that he wants to be able to sell growlers (a glass jug filled with draft beer from his tap) to his customers when they leave.

According to the attorney in order to sell growlers you have to have a liquor by the drink license or be a microbrewery.

Town ordinances, pertaining to off-premise consumption allows for package beer only. If this is to be allowed then the ordinances will have to be modified.

The attorney will do further research on the issue.

Cumberland Gap Market Beer Permit

Mayor McGaffee asked that a letter be sent to the owner of the Cumberland Gap Market stating that her license was revoked since the business closed. The recorder stated that she has spoken with the owner and she is aware and will turn the permit back in.
