Special Event Beer Permit Application- The Lincoln Memorial University- College of Veterinary Medicine's Student organization will be hosting an event, Josh Project Silent Auction, on September 29, 2018 at the Cumberland Gap Convention Center. Only beer and wine will be served, they are currently applying for a Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC) permit. Each attendee is allowed a 2 drink maximum per person with a licensed and insured bartender on site.

The Josh Project is an organization that helps to supply stuffed animals to children who are staying overnight or long-term in hospitals of the local organizations choosing. The proceeds from the auction go to purchasing as many boxes as possible to disseminate to the children once they are received.

Phillip Waller made a motion to approve the special event beer permit application contingent on proof of licensing from the group supervising & responsible for dispensing the alcoholic beverages.
